

Is there anywhere we can go that God doesn't see? Is there anything we can think that God doesn't hear? Sometimes, we think we can do something or think something and we convince ourselves that we are the only ones who know. But deep down, we know that God *does* know and we begin to feel guilt over our actions and thoughts.

First we need to understand that God does see and hear all things. If He didn't, He wouldn't be God! God knows everything we do, in public and in private. One of His attributes is Omniscience. That means that He knows all things. An attribute of God is not any different than an attribute of a book. Some attributes of a book are a front cover, a back cover and pages. There is no book without these things. And there is no God without Omniscience.

Psalm 139 tells us that there is nowhere we can go to hide from God. We are an open book to Him. He sees us and knows our thoughts no matter where we are. Do we pray to God in silence? Do we think He hears our prayers when we meditate in our hearts? When we do something wrong, but we did it because we thought it was the right thing to do at the time, we like to say that God knows our heart. If God can hear our thoughts when we pray and knows our hearts when we do things, then why do we think that He is suddenly blind and deaf when we do things or think things that we don't want Him to know?

Newsflash – He Knows! We sin, then we pretend that we didn't and we lie to God about it. When we fall short and do those things we shouldn't or even think those things we shouldn't, we need to remember that there is nowhere we can go to hide from God. So instead of hiding from Him and feeling guilty about it, let's come clean – let's ask Him for forgiveness. We'll feel better and so will He. Then let's repent. Be Holy as He is Holy!
